- It allows you to find the information you need quickly and easily
- Careerscape contains a range of exciting features including photographs, videos and case studies
- You can use Careerscape to find up to date information to help you plan your future







Getting Started

A number of options are available from the opening screen of Careerscape to help you with the program (subject to site restrictions).

-  Quick Tour - Gives you an overview of Careerscape and how it can help you
-  Where can I...? - A detailed look at where you can find different types of information in Careerscape
-  Video show - Watch short films about working in different industries

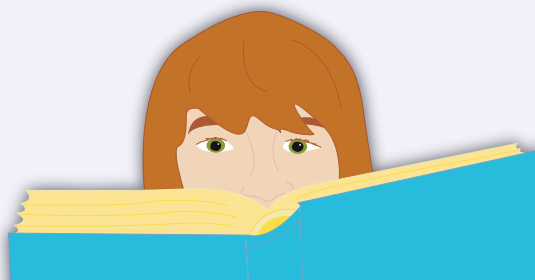
Using Careerscape

Within the program there are a number of features to assist in navigating your way around and finding information:

-  Main Menu - returns to the main menu screen
-  Back - enables you to return to the previous screen
-  Bookmark - this allows you to save articles to return to later in your session
-  Print - enables you to print articles for future reference (if available)
-  Help - provides help with the section you are currently using
-  Options - here you can turn off sound and link to other CASCAiD programs

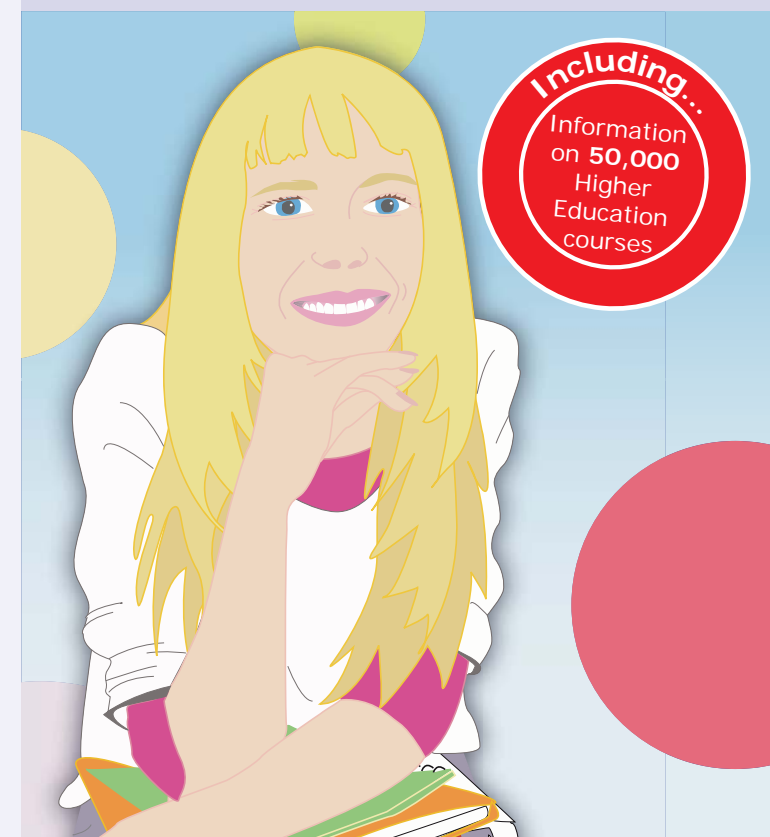
Hints and Tips for using Careerscape

- Use the Subject Links to find out what careers subjects are useful for. Helpful for choosing which subjects to study
- Not sure which section of Careerscape to use? Use the Wordsearch facility to search through all of the articles
- Use the Bookmark facility to save articles you come across during your search and return to them to review or print later
- You can get more information on careers and other issues that interest you by contacting organisations listed in the Further Information section
- You can use photographs from Careerscape to illustrate projects. Simply click on the copy button and paste into your document
- Print out copies of the information you find - you can discuss it with an adviser, or use it to help you with course or job applications
- If you want further information about the HE courses you have discovered, use the email link or contact address of the institution to ask for a prospectus or more information
- You can use the Internet version, Careerscape Online at home if you have web access. Ask your teacher or adviser for the log in details
- If you are unsure about where to start with your career search, ask a teacher or adviser if you can use a program called Kudos. This will help to give you initial ideas

- Select All Careers from the Careers Selector section
 - Choose a career from the list or type an idea into the box

- Choose the level of career information for you using the Full or Brief tabs
 - Find out more about each career by clicking on the sections
 - If the career links to Higher Education qualifications, the HE Course Information section enables you to look at relevant courses
 - There may be a case study which enables you to see someone's own opinions of their career
 - There may be photographs and videos to illustrate the main work activities
 - Use the Related button to link to careers which are similar

2 I'm not sure about what career I want more information on...

- Select Multi-Selector from the Careers Selector section
- Select as many factors as you wish from each of the Career Level, Industry and Type of Work tabs
- As you choose factors the careers list will change based on your areas of interest
- Select any of the career titles for more information
- See section 1b above

3 I want to find out what I can do with the subjects I am studying...

- Select Subjects from the Subject Links section
- Choose a subject from the list
- View detailed information on the types of career that the subject is useful for
- Use Related Articles to link directly to similar careers mentioned in the article and get more information on them

4 I know an area of work I am interested in and want to find out about related careers...

- Select one of the topics from the Career Families section
- Choose a Career Family from the list
- View detailed information about the types of work and individual careers that make up this family
- Use Related Articles to link to more information on careers mentioned in the article
- There may be a Career Family video available. This allows you to view careers that are part of this family

5 I want to find out more about education and training options open to me...

- Choose Education and Training from the General Information section
- Select an article from the list that you want more information on

6 I want more information on the world of work or employment initiatives...

- Choose Employment from the General Information section
- Select an article from the list that you want more information on

7 I want to find out about the lifestyle issues which may affect my choices...

- Choose Lifestyle: 13-19 Year Olds from the General Information section
- Select an article from the list you want more information on
- All of the articles include more information on where to get help and advice

8 I want to find out about Higher Education courses...

- Select Course Information from the Higher Education section
- Select any Keywords you would like to use as part of your course search
- Select Region/s you would like to search for courses in
- Select the Level/s of course you would like to search for
- Appropriate courses will be displayed
- Click on an institution name to get more information
